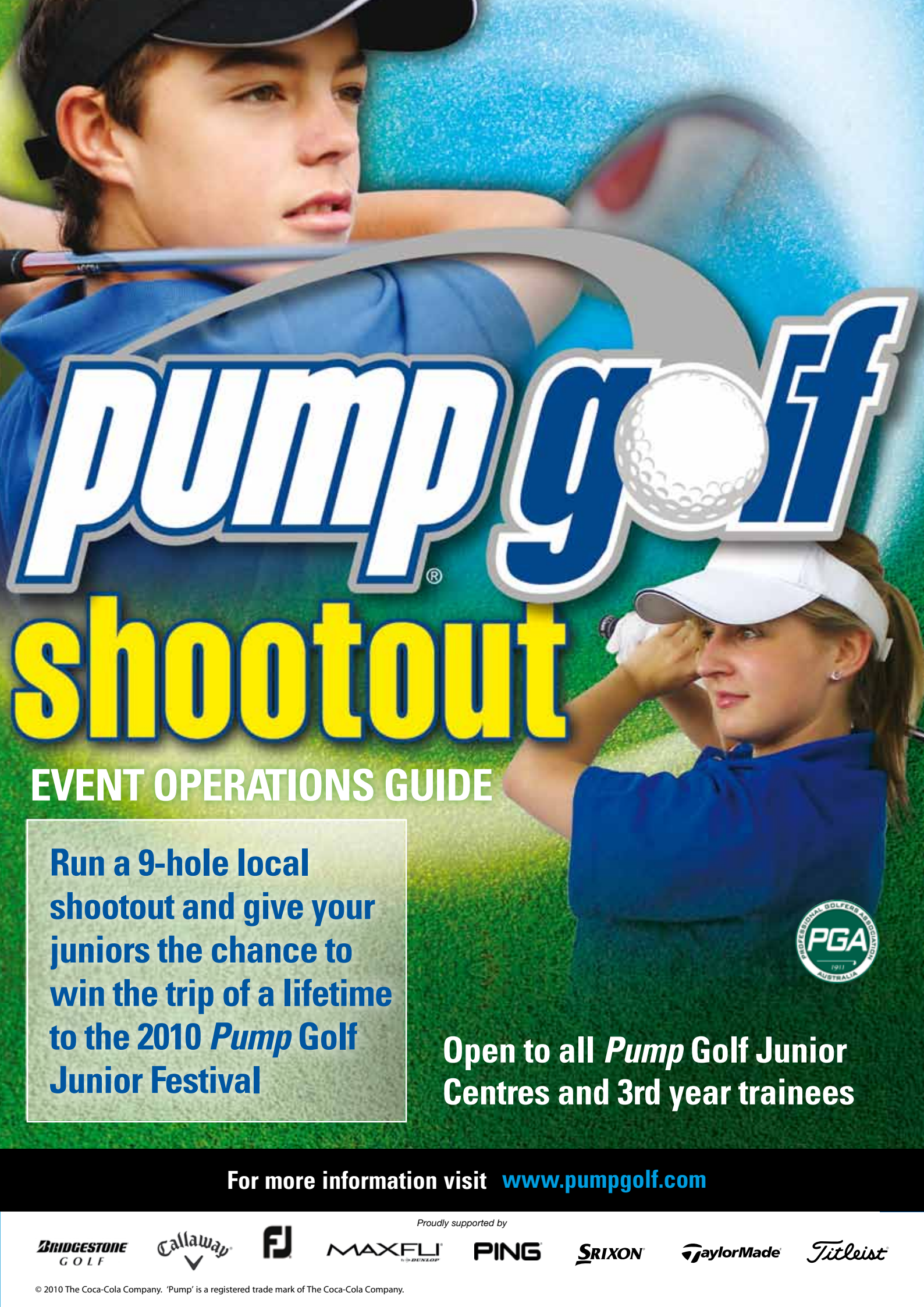

Welcome to the *Pump Golf* Shootout. The aim of the Shootout is to give your juniors a chance to win the "trip of a lifetime" to the 2010 Pump Golf Junior Festival.

This event also presents you with the opportunity to attract new juniors and expose the services you and your club provide.

2010 Pump Golf Junior Festival

Approximately 80 lucky juniors will be drawn from the national pool of scratch and net winners to win a place at the Junior Festival. All states and territories will be represented.

A nominal fee of \$300 (incl GST) is payable to the PGA for juniors who win a place to attend the Junior Festival of Golf. We encourage the club to sponsor this fee for their winner(s) or assist them with fundraising at the club. Juniors' air fares*, meals, accommodation and camp activities valued from \$1,200 are otherwise all-inclusive.

Key dates for the Shootout in 2010

April 17 – October 10	Staging Period for Your Local Shootout event
October 18 (week commencing)	Winners announced
December 7 - 10	2010 <i>Pump Golf</i> Junior Festival held in QLD

EVENT INFORMATION QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

● What am I required to do?

All you have to do is host a 9-hole stroke event for the juniors at your facility aged up to 16 yrs old during the event staging period.

● When is the event staging period?

You can run your junior Shootout event anytime from April 17 to October 10, 2010.

● How do I register my event and get a staging kit?

In order to run an event, you must complete and return the event registration form (located overleaf. Once your event is registered, the details will be placed on www.pumpgolf.com and your staging kit will be dispatched.

● What do I get in my Event Staging Kit

Following your event registration and prior to your event we will send you a staging kit which will include the following items:

- Participation gift for every junior
- Registration & Results Summary sheets
- Winners trophies (Scratch & Net)
- Post event Reconciliation, Payment & Winners form
- Draft press release to utilise with local media

● How can I promote my local event and will I receive anything from the PGA to assist?

As part of your staging kit you will receive an event poster. This will have spaces to insert specific details about your event. The PGA will also list your event

on the events page at www.pumpgolf.com. We also suggest sending out a press release to any local media to promote the event in the community. Club notice boards and newsletters also provide a great promotional opportunity for your event.

● How much does it cost me?

There is no cost to host a *Pump Golf* Shootout.

● How much does it cost the juniors?

A \$10.00 (incl GST) event entry fee is payable to the PGA for each junior who participates in your local Shootout event. This is reconciled by you post event and payment must be provided when you send in your winners details. Therefore, you may wish to cover the costs of green fees, extra prizes, drinks or other additional costs in the price you charge the junior participants over and above the \$10.00

● A Pricing Idea

The following is an example of a pricing structure which has worked quite well in the past. By no means is this compulsory, just one option you may wish to explore.

Entry Fee for PGA	\$10.00
Sausage Sizzle	\$4.00
Extra Trophies/Prizes	\$3.00
Surplus	\$3.00
YOU CHARGE	\$20.00 for the day

● On the Day of your Event

Welcome all players to the event and outline the rules and way that juniors can qualify to attend the 2010 *Pump Golf* Junior Festival. Ensure juniors are aware of their Shootout (or 9-hole) handicap and are comfortable with marking the card of another junior.

● Presentation of Trophies

In your staging kit, you will be provided with some trophies for your net and scratch winners along with a participation gift for every entrant. You may wish to compliment these prizes on the day depending on the number of juniors that participate.

● What do the juniors get?

Just for signing up and having a go all juniors will receive a specially designed *Pump Golf* visor and water bottle. These participation gifts will be sent with your staging kit.

● What if the juniors don't have a handicap?

In the local junior shootout rules there are details on how to calculate a shootout handicap. (see shootout rules for more details)

● Post event

Complete the "Reconciliation, Payment & Winners" form, nominating your preferred payment method.

Post, fax or email these forms along with a list of all your juniors names, ages and scratch & net scores on the "Registration & Results Summary" sheets to the PGA.

● What is the Pump Golf Junior Festival?

The Pump Golf Junior Festival is the final event of the year for the Pump Golf Junior Golf Program where winners from around the country converge on Queensland's Sunshine Coast for an action packed golfing trip. In 2010 there will again be an international junior tournament which Australian juniors will participate in, along with other juniors from the Australasian region.

● When and where is the 2010 Pump Golf Junior Festival being held?

The event is being held at Novotel Twin Waters Resort Tuesday 7th December until Friday 10th December 2010.

● How do juniors qualify to attend?

A random draw will take place in October and successful juniors will be notified. Both your scratch and net winners will be entered into this draw.

● What can the juniors who win the trip expect?

Juniors can expect an action packed few days filled with plenty of golf, fun activities, coaching and development. They will meet other juniors from around Australia and the Australasian region as they participate in the 2010 Pump Golf Junior Festival. The juniors also have the opportunity to meet and hang out with tour players. In addition to all this, a visit to the 2010 Australian PGA Championship is included to watch the stars of the game live in action.

● How will winning juniors be notified?

Junior winners will be displayed on the PGA website, written to directly and notified through the club where they participated in the local shootout. **NB** When submitting your results to the PGA please ensure that at the very least you have provided a contact address and phone number for your two local event winners (net & scratch).

● Supervision at the Junior Festival

All daytime and evening activities are fully supervised. Winners aged 12 and under are required to be accompanied by an adult parent or guardian to enable direct supervision overnight during the Junior Festival of Golf. Air transport for accompanying adult(s) will be offered in the group seating allocation at the PGA reduced rate. The air fare, meals and other personal expenses will be the responsibility of the accompanying adult.

If a primary school-aged junior cannot be accompanied, a substitute junior will be drawn.

● \$300 Participation Fee

A nominal fee of \$300 (incl GST) is payable to the PGA for juniors who win a place to attend the 2010 Pump Golf Junior Festival. Winners' air fares, meals, accommodation and camp activities (valued at \$1,200) are otherwise all-inclusive.

LOCAL JUNIOR SHOOTOUT RULES

Age

Junior golfers aged up to and including 16 years during the Shootout staging period April 17 to October 10, 2010 are eligible. **NB** (Juniors under the age of 10 are allowed to participate but are not eligible to win the major prize)

Shootout Convener

1. Each Shootout event must have a nominated PGA Professional or Trainee Professional to carry out the official duties of the Shootout Convener.
2. The Shootout Convener is responsible for all rules, scores and any matters requiring attention on the day.

Singles Stroke Event

1. The Pump Golf Shootout is a 9-hole singles stroke event.
2. Each player is required to write their stroke score, handicap and net result on the scorecard. Scratch & Net results are used to determine each club's winner.

Calculating the shootout handicap

1. Official 18 hole Club handicap (halved)
2. Play 2 appropriately supervised games of 9 holes from the designated markers.
Add up the two 9-hole stroke scores
Example: 45 + 52 = 97
Divide by two (rounding up if required) = 48.5,
round up = 49
Deduct the 9-hole par 49 – 36 (par)
Shootout Handicap 13

Tee Markers

1. As set by the shootout convener
2. All players play from the same tees and play the same 9 holes of the course.
3. Girls are eligible to play from the ladies markers and use the ladies par.

Score Cards

1. Each player is required to carry a scorecard and score for another competitor.
2. Each card must have a stroke score, Shootout handicap, and two signatures.
3. Players may be given 10 minutes to check their cards prior to submitting.
4. Junior registration information must be completed in full.

In the event of a tie

1. A count back will be required (ie. Last six holes, last three holes then hole by hole until a winner is decided)

Equipment

1. Each player must carry and use one set of clubs (maximum 14 clubs)
2. Players are not permitted to share clubs.

Caddies

1. Caddies are not permitted (or as determined by the Shootout Convener).

Discrepancies

1. The Shootout Convener will make a decision based on the information presented.
2. Players who wish to bring a matter to the attention to the PGA are required to submit a letter to the PGA National Office within 7 days of the event.
